
TRAVEL DIRECTIONS TO BULMERSHE SCHOOL, CHEQUERS WAY, WOODLEY, READING, RG5 3EL

The car park entrance to Bulmershe School is via Chequers Way (off Howth Drive), just South of the A4 in Woodley. Please note that there is no access to the School Site via Woodlands Avenue. A one-way system will be in operation and Woodlands Avenue will be used as an exit. Car parking is £3.00 that includes a free programme. Additional programmes may be purchased for £1. Please do not park on the main roads surrounding the school. Dogs are not allowed on the sports ground.



From Reading: take the A4 towards Maidenhead. Go past the A329M and continue ahead at the next roundabout. At the next roundabout (Shepherds Hill), go all the way round and take the first left down Reading Road (signposted Woodley). Turn right onto Howth Drive and then right onto Chequers Way. The entrance to Bulmershe School is at the end of Chequers Way.

From Bracknell and the South East: take the A329(M) to Reading. At the junction with the A4, turn right towards Maidenhead and follow the instructions as from Reading above.

From the West: take the M4 towards London. Leave at Junction 10 and keep left onto the A329(M) to Reading. At the junction with the A4, turn right towards Maidenhead as above.

From Hampshire: take the A33 towards Reading. At the junction with the M4, turn right towards London and then as above.

From High Wycombe and further north: Take the A404 from the large roundabout above the M40 (junction 4) and head south towards the M4. Leave at the intersection with the A4 and turn right towards Reading. Follow the A4 to Charvil. When the dual carriageway section ends at a roundabout, continue ahead. At the next

roundabout (Shepherds Hill), take the first left down Reading Road (signposted Woodley). Turn right onto Howth Drive and then right onto Chequers Way. The entrance to Bulmershe School is at the end of Chequers Way.

From Caversham and Henley: Go over the Thames through Sonning Village. At the end of the village continue over a miniroundabout until you reach the A4. At the roundabout turn right towards reading and follow the instructions from High Wycombe as above.
